ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

(General Laws, Chapter 180)

ARTICLE I

The exact name of the corporation is:

Harvard Acres Homeowners Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following activities:

- 1. To preserve and protect the land owned in common within the Harvard Acres development within the Town of Stow, Massachusetts.
- 2. To acquire land and interests in land and dispose of the same through conveyance, gift or otherwise.
- 3. To take all lawful steps to preserve and protect the quality of life within the Harvard Acres development.

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Note: If the space provided under any article or item on this form is insufficient, additions shall be set forth on one side only of separate 8 1/2 x 11 sheets of paper with a left margin of at least 1 inch. Additions to more than one article may be made on a single sheet so long as each article requiring each addition is clearly indicated.

ARTICLE III

A corporation may have one or more classes of members. If it does, the designation of such classes, the manner of election or appointments, the duration of membership and the qualification and rights, including voting rights, of the members of each class, may be set forth in the by-laws of the corporation or may be set forth below:
