We hope this annual letter finds you well.

As a volunteer-run committee, the Harvard Acres Homeowners Association (HAHA) relies on support from the community to cover *maintenance, insurance, and property tax* costs for our shared land on Conant Drive.

To help with these efforts, we are requesting **\$60 per household** in voluntary dues this year. These funds are a big step toward fully resurfacing the tennis courts, which we hope to tackle in the next year or two.

Any contribution, large or small, is welcome and appreciated — we know everyone’s situation is different. In the past, surplus funds have supported neighborhood events like the ice cream social and annual picnic.

You don’t need to play tennis, pickleball, or basketball to enjoy this shared space — it’s there for all of us. The more neighbors that pitch in, the better we can care for this cherished part of Harvard Acres.

Our tennis courts are reaching the end of their life and we are hoping to resurface them at the end of Summer 2027. Because we anticipate resurfacing will cost more than \$20,000, we left our suggested dues at \$60. If you’re able to contribute more than this amount, it will go directly to the tennis court fund. Although a professional was hired in 2022 to fill the cracks and imperfections, resurfacing will be needed to prevent major damage and extend their life. *We’d love the extra help to keep the courts in great shape.*

HARVARD ACRES FREE DAY


Saturday, May 2 @ 8 a.m.
